Directions to Los Burros Camp Ground

From Show Low:

Take Highway 60 east to Vernon at the Midway Store turn right (south) onto Forest Service Road (FSR) 224, the Vernon – McNary Road. Travel south on FSR 224 approximately 11.5 miles to the Los Burros Camp Ground.

From Pinetop:

Take Highway 260 east to McNary turn left (north) on the Vernon – McNary road approximately mid town. Drive north on FSR 224 for approximately 7 miles to the Los Burros Camp Ground.

There will be some camping space available at the camp ground. There is abundant dispersed camping available throughout the area. If you need assistance locating a good camp spot check with staff when you arrive to find a spot that will meet your needs.
